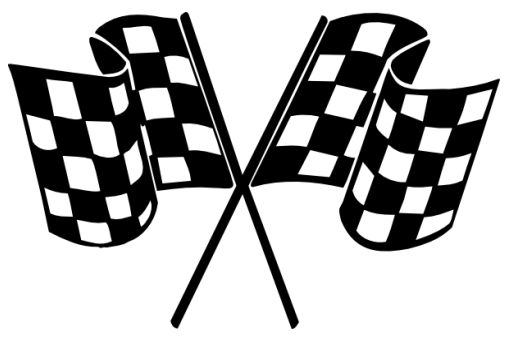

**Incentive Program**



Our primary goal of implementing this reward program is so that each and every student at Seminole Science Charter School feels encouraged and challenged to read. The "Rev up for Reading" Program was created to encourage student reading through a rewards program and unite readers and the school. Readers are rewarded for the number of Accelerated Reader and Sunshine State Books they read within a specific time period. Every time a student reads an AR book and takes and passes an AR test at 85% or higher (on their specific reading level), they will earn points.

Students who read Sunshine State Books, and pass AR tests at 85% or higher, will be eligible for an end of the year celebration. Students must read these books and take the AR tests before May 1.

Details for both programs are below.

### **A.R. Program Date Ranges**

Quarter 1: August 10 – October 10

Quarter 2: October 11 – December 31

Quarter 3: January 1 – March 11

Quarter 4: March 12 – May 6

### **Minimum points needed to participate in AR Quarterly Celebration Days**

Kindergarten (8 Points)      3<sup>rd</sup> Grade (18 Points)

1<sup>st</sup> Grade (10 Points)      4<sup>th</sup> Grade (20 Points)

2<sup>nd</sup> Grade (14 Points)      5<sup>th</sup> Grade (24 Points)

6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade (35 Points)

**Minimum points needed to participate in AR End of Year Celebration**

Kindergarten (35 Points)    3<sup>rd</sup> Grade (80 points)  
1<sup>st</sup> Grade (45 Points)        4<sup>th</sup> Grade (100 Points)  
2<sup>nd</sup> Grade (65 Points)       5<sup>th</sup> Grade (110 Points)  
6<sup>th</sup>- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade (130 Points)
