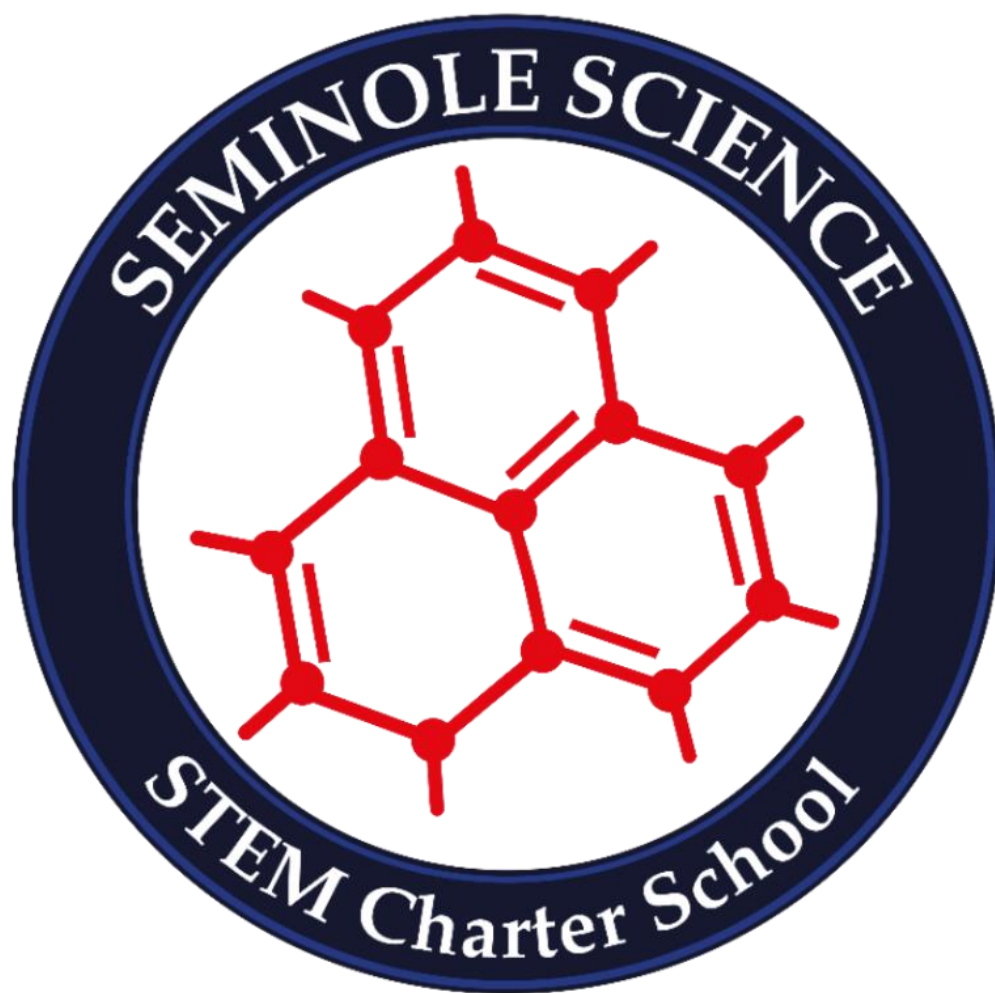

Club Descriptions *(in alphabetical order by title)*

Animal Adventures Club with Ms. Hoyle

Schedule: Tuesdays

Grades: K, 1

Fees: \$10

Students will discover amazing animals from around the world through stories, videos, crafts, and hands-on activities. Each week, students will learn about a different animal, its habitat, adaptations, and the ways people help protect wildlife. Art Club (K-2) with Mrs. Griffiths

Schedule: Thursdays

Grades: K, 1, 2

Fee: \$25

Students are expected to complete weekly Khan Academy to help them learn math in the next grade level. We compete in competitions about once a month and students are required to complete at least a few of these competitions.

Fee: \$10

***VEX Robotics with Mrs. Merrick & Mrs. Aviles**

Schedule: Tuesdays and Thursdays

Grades: 4, 5, 6, 7, 8

Fees: \$250

In VEX IQ Robotics Competition Club, students in 4th – 8th grade will have the opportunity to compete in the largest robotics competition in the world! Students will work in teams to design, build, code and drive a robot for the new season's competition game. Students are expected to create an engineering notebook to document their design, build, testing, and coding process. Club practices will take place twice a week after school and during Saturdays. Competitions usually take place on Saturdays and are all day, and students are expected to attend all practices and competitions. At competition, teams will participate in judged interviews, competitive matches, driver skills challenges, and programming skills challenges. VEX club is a student-based and student-led program only, so we are looking for highly motivated and committed students. No prior robotics experience is needed. Due to practice and competition constraints, students cannot be enrolled in FLL or Science Olympiad. Students will gain valuable teamwork, problem-solving, and engineering skills and have the unique experience of competing with teams from all across North America and around the world! All potential students are required to try-out during the first week of school. Annual Fee: \$250
